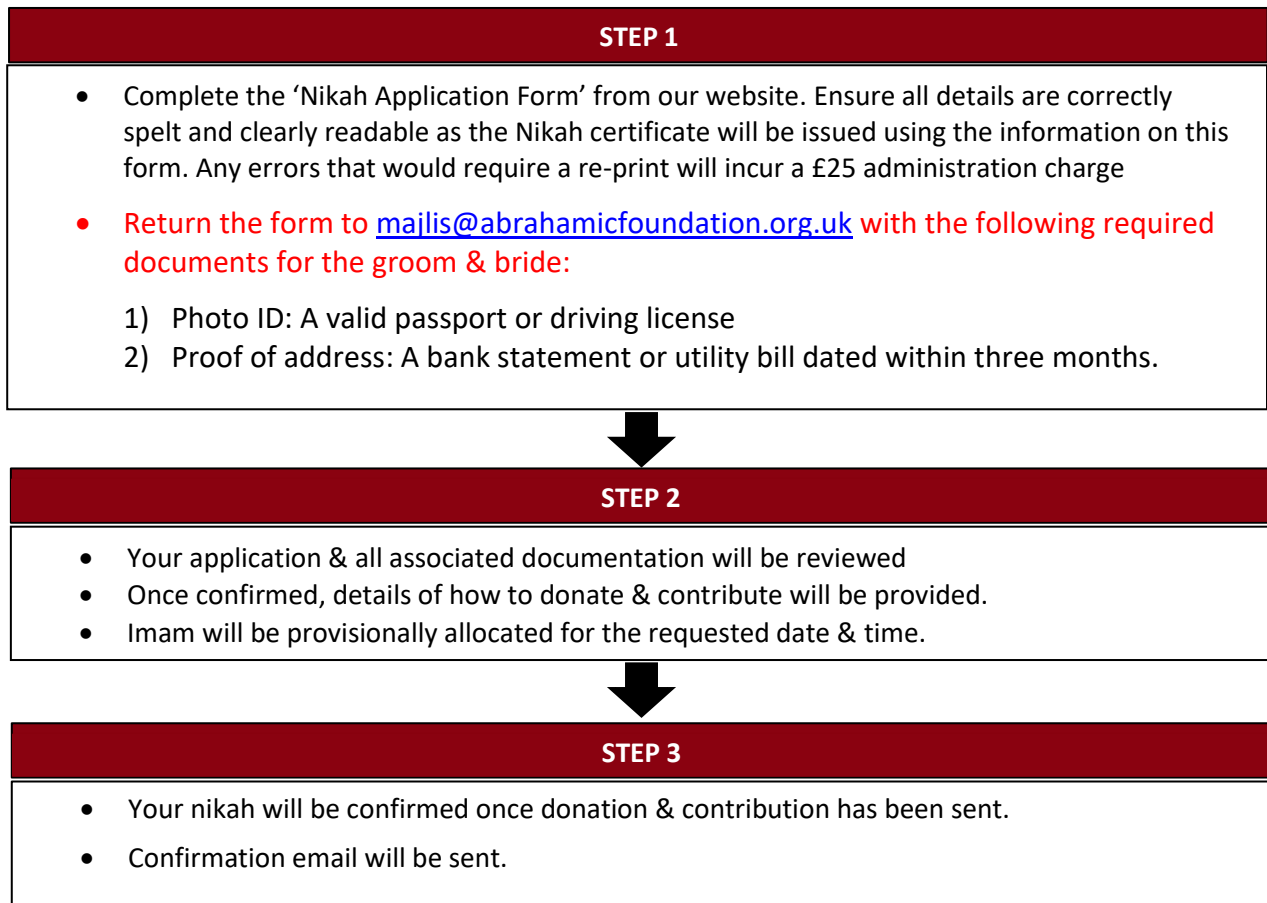




Important Information for your Nikah Procedure

We understand that Nikah is a special and auspicious occasion in our lives and in our deen. The Prophet (saw) said “*when a person gets married, he has completed half of his religion, so let him fear Allah with regard to the other half*” (al-Bayhaqi). At this beautiful moment in your life, we want to make sure that your Nikah is a celebration in which you have full confidence.





Please note:

1. On the day of the Nikah, the Imam will take consent from the bride and the groom in person. This means both parties must be present and accessible on the day.
2. Our Imam will only be available for 1 hour. Please carefully consider the exact time you have put on your Nikah Application Form.
3. A Nikah ceremony is an auspicious Islamic occasion. For the Imam to deliver a short reminder and dua the participants and venue must be quiet and respectful during this time.
4. We suggest that the Nikah service is conducted before or after food is served, to ensure that guests are fully engaged. If food is being served, music is being played and guests are unseated and loud, it is not befitting that an Islamic reminder or dua is made in such an environment.
5. The proposed couple may come in and meet a member of our Nikah team to go through the process and answer any questions if needed. The purpose of this meeting is to remove any qualms the proposed couple may have.

Contributions & Costs

The nikah contribution is £250 which is a donation & contribution used to cover the running costs of the nikah service as well as contributing towards the 50+ projects of the Abrahamic Foundation. This can be paid via cash or bank transfer and a certificate will be issued.

Additional Imam cost: Every hour will be £35.00 thereafter. An hour is considered to start by the lapse of the first, regardless of duration. (PLEASE NOTE: Failing to adhere to the time slot you have given to the Imam may result in the Imam leaving due to other dedications and appointments)

Additional Transportation Cost: If the venue is more than 10 miles from the Imams personal address then 55p per mile will be added to cover the Imam's fuel costs, or in the case of not having a car, the full cost of a taxi to and from the venue. You are more than welcome to send a car to pick up the Imam.



Courteous Remark: We do not consider it appropriate that the Imam is given payment for overtime in front of other members of the public. Please can you make this a personal and private matter.

Contributions & Donations are non-refundable.

For the certificates to be prepared on time, you must complete and return the Nikah Form 2 weeks prior to the Nikah. Failure to do so may result in the Nikah certificate being issued at a later date.

Nikah certificate will be issued by the Imam at the Nikah ceremony.

PLEASE NOTE: A nikah certificate is not a legal document and is not recognised as a registered marriage under British law. The nikah certificate serves as a record for Muslim law proceedings only.
